

Challenge: Tabernacle/Temple Building



Using one of the following put together your own Tabernacle or Temple and submit a 20-30 second video of your structure pointing out the different features in the building. Post your videos by 5pm 23/04/2020.

You can read God's instructions for the Tabernacle in Exodus 25-27 & 30, and for the Temple in 1 Kings 5-9:9 and 2 Chronicles 3-7.

The Tabernacle

Ex 26:1,6, 15 Make the tabernacle with ten curtains of finely twisted linen and blue, purple and scarlet yarn... then make fifty gold clasps and use them to fasten the curtains together so the tabernacle is a unit. Make upright frames of acacia wood.

The Temple

1 Kings 5:6, 6:2 give orders that cedars of Lebanon be cut...

the temple King Solomon built was 60 cubits long, twenty wide, thirty high. ... the portico stretched the width of the temple, ... with side rooms and and roof.

Include in your structure:

The Most Holy Place

Ex 26, 1 Kings 6:19-22 ... 20 cubits long, 20 cubits wide, 20 cubits high.

The Curtain

Ex 26:31, 33 Make a curtain of blue, purple and scarlet yarn and finely twisted linen. The curtain will separate the Holy Place from the Most Holy place.

The various furniture:

The Ark Ex 25:10, 11,16 Have them make a chest of acacia wood... overlay it with pure gold... then put in the Ark the testimony which I will give you.

The Table Ex 25:23, 30 Make a table... put the bread of the presence on this table.

The Lampstand Ex 25:31 Make a lampstand out of pure gold.

The Altar Ex 27:1 Build an altar out of acacia wood, 3 cubits high. It is to be square, 5 cubits long and 5 cubits wide.

The courtyard Ex 27:1, 18 Make a courtyard for the tabernacle... a hundred cubits long and fifty cubits wide.

The Basin Ex 30:18 Make a bronze basin with its bronze stand for washing. Place it in front of the tent of meeting and the altar.
