

As you pray, model what you're asking the kids to do. Take turns all listening to each other's prayers. Encourage everyone to pray out loud a simple 'Thank you', 'Sorry', and 'Please' sentence. A helpful method is for everyone to first pray the 'Thank you' prayer, then everyone the 'Sorry' prayer and finally 'Please'.

Prompt their phrases if necessary.

Today you might like to focus on THANKS and spend time thanking God for the promises he has made and keeps.

TSP	Suggested prompts
Thank You	Thank you God for
Sorry	Heavenly Father, I am sorry for
Please	Please God help me

After listening to the Kid talk, reading the passage/story & you may find one of the prayers reflect a particular response (i.e. praise (thanks) or repentance (sorry), major on that part of TSP.

Hebrews 11 Prayer:

For younger children say the prayer below in sections with them repeating after you. For older children either pray yourself or asK/nominate a child to read the prayer on behalf of you all.

Dear Heavenly Father, Thank you that you keep your promises. Thank you that what you say you will do. God, please help us remember your promises and trust you always. Please help us to always be sure of the hope we have in Jesus. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
