

Matthew 5:6-8

Refresh:

- 1. Who is Jesus speaking to?
- 2. What does it mean to be blessed?

Look for it:

- 1. What does it mean to be hungry and thirsty for what is right?
- 2. What does Jesus say is good for us to be sad about?
- 3. What does it mean to be humble?

Think about it:

- 1. Do you really really really want for everything to be made right? How is this want truly satisfied?
- 2. Why do we need to be shown mercy?
- 3. What do each of these ideas show us about God's Kingdom and Kingdom people?
- 4. How does the story of the good Samaritan show us this Topsy Turvy Kingdom living?
- 5. As People in God's Kingdom how can your behaviour show what is good and right? Who can you show mercy to?



As you pray, model what you're asking the kids to do. Take turns all listening to each other's prayers. Encourage everyone to pray out loud a simple 'Thank you', 'Sorry', and 'Please' sentence. A helpful method is for everyone to first pray the 'Thank you' prayer, then everyone the 'Sorry' prayer and finally 'Please'.
